# Why? Processing purposes & legal basis for processing

We would like to collect certain personal information from you to keep you up to date with the activities of MAC<sup>2</sup>. In other words, these personal data will be used for communication purposes. We want to

The withdrawal of your consent does not, however, affect the lawfulness of the processing based on the consent prior to the withdrawal of your consent. In other words, you can only withdraw your consent for the future, not for the past.

Finally, we do not take any automatic decisions (based on profiling or otherwise) that affect you in any way whatsoever.

b) Personal data we receive automatically

c) Personal data we receive from third parties

# Recipients of personal data

## Rights
